Facing discrimination in various areas of life such as employment, housing, family, healthcare, and education.

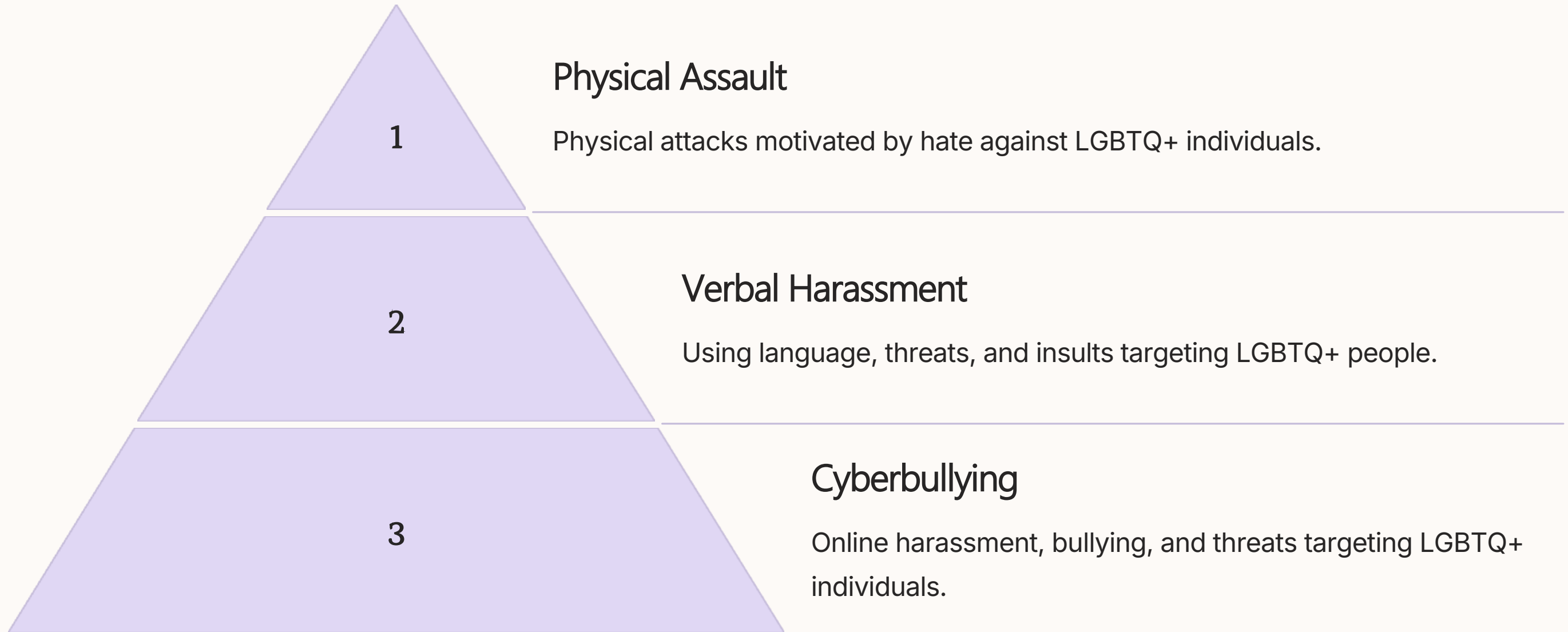
Mental Health
