Gender Identity vs Sex

- Sex: Biological characteristics (chromosomes, hormones, anatomy)
 - Gender Identity: How a person internally identifies (man, woman, non-binary, etc.)
 - Difference: Sex is assigned at birth, gender identity is self-perceived



Gender Roles

- Social expectations based on gender
 - Influence how people should behave, dress, or interact
 - Often shaped by culture, tradition, and media



Gender Stereotypes

- Simplified, rigid beliefs about genders
 - Examples: 'Men are strong, women are emotional'
 - Limit personal expression and opportunities



Problems Related to Gender

- Discrimination and inequality
 - Gender-based violence and harassment
 - Wage gap and limited opportunities
 - Mental health challenges due to pressure




Solutions
